## The European Showmanship Judges Panel

## Introduction

In 2013 a European Showmanship Panel was established, listing qualified Judges who are recommended to officiate at European Showmanship competitions.

In 2020 the Judges Panel Working Group reviewed the Showmanship Panel, defining rules for listing.

The initial procedure is as follows:

- 1. Each country can propose a maximum of two Showmanship Judges.
- 2. A CV for each Showmanship Judge must be emailed to the Secretary General. CV's should contain information on the engagement at young breeders activities, showmanship activities both national and international and the ability to judge a showmanship in English.
- 3. The Secretary General will send the CVs to the Judges Panel Working Group, who will agree the European Showmanship Panel.
- 4. The new panel will be published on the website and sent out to all members.

This list will be reviewed every two years.
